MAN'S CREATION MIRRORS GOD'S NATURE

• Gen. 1: 26—"Then God said, 'Let Us make humanity in Our image, according to Our likeness, and let them rule over the earth. God created humanity in His own image, in the image of God He created mankind; male and female He created them."



Isaiah 66:13—"as a mother comforts her child, so I will comfort you."

Feminine qualities in God:
nurturing, accepting, affirming,
nourishing, comforting,
imparting life to others,
provides rest, security, peace

Examples in scripture of God's feminine nature

Exodus 34:6-7—"Yahweh, Yahweh, compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, over-flowing with loyal love and faithfulness."

Compassion—Hebrew word rakhum related to word for "womb," rekhem
God as compassionate "depicts God as having the nurture and emotional love felt by a mother for her vulnerable, unborn child; god is depicted as compassionate (suffering along with)---deeply moved by the cries of His people, like a mom is moved by the cries of her infant."

Examples in scripture of God's feminine nature

Hosea 11:3-4—God as a mother feeding her babies

Hosea 13:8—God as a fierce mother bear

Isa. 49:15—God as a nursing mom

Matt. 23:37—Jesus compares Himself to a mother hen, gathering her chicks

1 Thess. 2:7-12—"but we proved to be gentle among you, as a nursing mother tenderly feeds and cares for her own children."

Her personality and spiritual qualities: "a compassionate but tough spiritual director/spiritual mother, and a fiercely loving parent."

Extremely disciplined and well-organized with very high expectations for her children

"the purpose of biblical truth is to provide us with a renewed mind that leads to loving god and loving others."

"What is the duty of a mother? To do all the good for a child she can. How does a mother fulfil her duty? By conversing lovingly about life in light of god's word."



Dedicated to prayer "apron prayers" 2 hrs. per day



Maintained devotion to meditation on and the study of scripture

*Maintained devotion to self-examination (seeking God and confession of known sin)

*followed by daily communion — loved "self-examination—"confession of sin" 3 times per day, the final time followed by personal communion

"confessing sins in order to underline one's reliance on the mercy of god." Believed in the "real presence" in communion



*Maintained devotion to sabbath *called it that "most happy day"

"a day for devotions rather than diversions"



Spent one hour per evening of quality time with one child
